

Apprentice Greenkeeper

Forster Bowling Club is located on the Mid North Coast and is calling for applications from interested persons who want to undertake a four-year apprenticeship in greenkeeping (or second- or third-year apprentice will be considered). To succeed in this role applicants should have the following qualities:

- Genuine interest in horticulture and working outdoors.

- Willingness to learn.
- Flexibility with work hours during busy periods of the year
- Ideally possess drivers' licence and own transport
- Willingness to attend TAFE at Kurri Kurri for four-day blocks once a month. This will require overnight stays on campus with own transport required.

The role will require early starts (5.30am). Morning weekend work will also be required on a rotating roster. Your work duties will involve all aspects of greenkeeping including mowing greens, rolling greens, renovating sports turf surfaces, repairing irrigation systems, turf machinery maintenance and repairs, and general gardening. This role also requires physical work and occasional heavy lifting.
